Scott Geiselhart tells a firefighter's story of survival and gives message of hope for PTSD and suicide victims. Hear Scott tell how he escaped near death on his road to discovery and recovery from his post-traumatic stress disorder. Scott reached out. He made the call to get better. Dennis Carradin from the DVFA CISM will team-up with Scott and discuss how to recognize stress in the emergency worker. He will differentiate between normal stress and critical stress.
